Updates for 17/11

IOM : The IOM CCCM team have identified another evacuation camp in the Pilar area at Dulungan National High School. The area is very isolated and the people have been moved out of the school by the local government due to pressure to reopen the school. The IDP's have set up a makeshift camp near the school which is also very close to their place of origin. There are 52 families there. A DTM will be submitted for this location.

General observation not just at the above site is that 90% of families would move home if they had access to a shelter kit and construction materials to rebuild their houses.

A camp manager has been identified for this camp.

Additionally, visits were made to Dona Victoria Elementary School and Kalangkaan Elementary School and Camp Managers identified for both sites.

Meetings with camp managers will be convened and information boards detailing statistics and issues will be installed at each location.

STC – Save the Children reported that they plan to partner with DWSD to address issues related to the lack of child friendly facilities at the EC's. This involves meeting camp managers, so it was agreed that Camp Manager meetings would be conducted jointly with IOM and STC representatives present.

DART reported that the Pontevedra Mayor was eager for all EC's to be closed – Friday is the deadline set.

IOM reported that UNICEF had installed six pre-fab toilets at the Davidas Civic Center and that a further quantity were set to be installed at Dulungan Elementary School in Pilar.

Humanity First were also welcomed to the CCCM cluster and agreed to conduct DTM assessments in Iloilo on behalf of IOM.

GOAL were not present at the meeting but have also indicated willingness to assist in Iloilo, likewise ACF who have been assigned the Estencia Evacuation Camp.

Plans for 18/11

Humanity First – traveling to Concepcion with the DART team and also to islands off the coast of Estancia. DTM forms to be completed by HF where centers found.

STC reported their focus would be Municipal coordination.

IOM reported that their DG would be visiting accompanied by the Exec Director of WFP. Davidas Civic center to be visited.
