

Minutes from the CCCM Cluster meeting held 7pm 18/11.

Updates;

IOM

- DG of IOM accompanied by the Executive Director of WFP had been on site to Pontevedra Evac Camps during the day.
- For IOM – DTM finalized for Dulungan National High School

- Reports from Dona Victoria
 - of no food rations since Friday.
 - Continued accessibility issues
 - Excessive price for drinking water
- Pontevedra NHS & Dativas Civic Center
 - Friday deadline to clear camp set by local government

Humanity First

- Hassan reported that he had visited Sicogan Island – privately owned off the coast of Norther Iloilo. Owner requesting establishment of an Evac camp for approx 6000 people.

After the meeting Atta from HF provided the following information from his trip to Iloilo that day;

- Concepcion – several camps reported 46 families approx 200 people
- Sara – possibly as many as 26 small camps covering 244 individuals

DART

- Reported that medical clinics had been conducted at Dativas Civic Center and Dona Victoria Elem School. Unfortunately this was done unilaterally, so details of care provided and number of patients per center are vague. Total treated across the 2 sites was estimated at 150.

Child Fund attended with STC and reported that they were identifying welfare workers to partner with for child friendly facility development at the Pilar and Pontevedra EC's.

They reported that some of the population for Dulungan ES were unable to meet the deadline to move out because their place of origin (Cantin) is still heavily flooded. It was recorded as an action item that we need to identify how many of the population off approx 300 at this camp are affected by this issue.

Actions for 19th

DART and IOM to coordinate further activities in relation to medical clinics to ensure statistics are kept going forward.

Jerel reported that he was preparing information kits for Camp Managers and would commence meeting with them in coordination with STC.

Post meeting it was agreed that GOAL would attempt to start completing DTM forms in Iloilo focusing initially on Sara and Concepcion.

ACF have been on site in a camp in Estancia but no DTM has yet been submitted – an action was recorded for IOM and ACF to share information on the Estancia camp so that a DTM can be submitted to ensure the site is officially on the radar.
