

Minutes from the CCCM Cluster meeting held 7pm 19/11.

Updates:

- IOM Medical team identified 6 new EC sites in Pilar and Pontevedra areas that will require DTM matrix completion – information was received from barangay health workers
- GOAL provided 4 DTM forms detailing specific camps in the Estencia area – GPS coordinates not yet known however. ACF provided summary level information for Estancia.'
- Sara is an area of concern with vastly contrasting information coming from different sources. DART team advised that they were aware that EC's were being proactively cleared to allow for preparation for school restarts. This issue of premature return to people to unsafe places of origin was highlighted to the shelter cluster team for prioritization of shelter kit distribution.

Plans for tomorrow;

- DART medical team will be active in Sara tomorrow. It was agreed that an IOM team member would accompany them with the dual purpose of documenting medical treatment and also gathering intelligence on where people may be prematurely returning to unsafe places of origin. The resulting intell will be shared with the Shelter cluster in order to assist them with targeting shelter kit distribution.
- DART medical team will also be deployed to Pilar. 2 EC's will be attended for purposes of running medical clinics. IOM staff will coordinate the treatment and perform registration and statistical gathering.
 - o Dulungan National High School – first visit
 - o Dulungan Elementary School – follow up visit.
- IOM Camp management team will continue to work on camp management initiatives at the previously identified Capiz EC's.
- IOM Camp management team also to make plans to how to complete DTM's for the 6 newly identified Capiz EC's
- ACF will distribute hygiene kits tomorrow with Dulungan Elementary School an intended location – they will provide feedback to CCCM tomorrow on actual distribution.
