Demography:

- The site: accessible by land
- Identified vulnerable groups include pregnant women, breastfeeding mothers, persons with disability and unaccompanied minors.

Shelter

- Site type: is evacuation center (schools / classrooms)
- The conditions: Crowded. There are no on-site cooking are nor electricity

Food

- The center received its first time food distribution on November 15th. It was for a one day ration/supply.
- The DTM revealed 3 key aspects of the food supply management: 1. that the frequency of distribution is unknown, b. there has been no supplementary food for children or pregnant and c. some food items distributed were insufficient.
- Furthermore, there is no “anticipated schedule” or information as to when they will receive additional food for this month.

Water, Sanitation and Hygiene

- There are existing functioning water tanks/catchments on-site. Some IDPs have household drinking water containers.
- There is only one latrine at the site. There are no toilets located a safe distance from the dwelling areas and there is no separate female and male toilet.
- Waste management: there are problems with solid waste disposal at the site. Garbage clearance is done by incineration method.

Health

- The common diseases faced by the IDPs include skin diseases, injury, wound infection, cough, cold / flu (URTI) and fever.
- There is no health referral system in place or groups providing health services at the site.
- There is no information available yet on **Surveillance in Post Extreme Emergencies and Disasters (SPEED)** conducted by DoH at the site.

Education

- There are no informal educational activity at the site. Children are out of school.

Protection

- There is a lack of female Tanod / Police presence. The security is not assured 24/7.
