### DMT results and analysis for Typhoon Haiyan, No.005

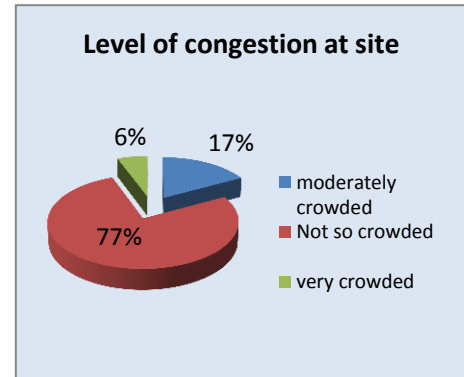
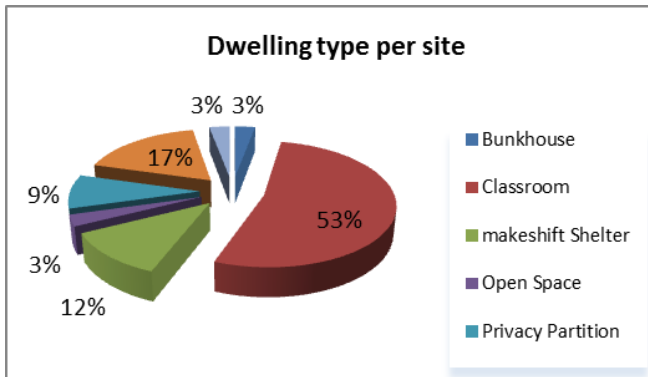

### Shelter

- From the total 38 sites assessed, the most common shelters used are classrooms (53%), followed by room (17%), makeshift shelter (12%). The level of congestion at each site is reported not so crowded (77%).
- All of the sites have no on-site electricity, 19 sites are described safe for on-site cooking and 13 sites are located safe from natural hazards.

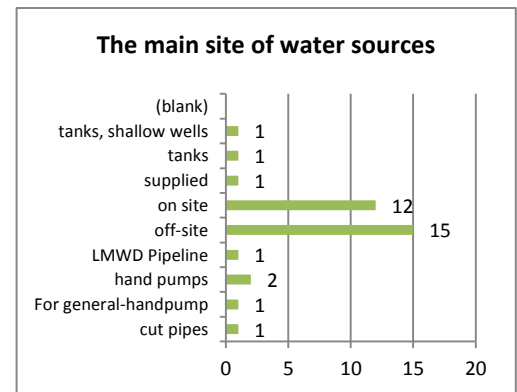


### Food supplement

- Near to half of the centers (or 46%) received a food distribution of weekly basis (for 1 to 1.5 day supplies). Food, water, medicine are the most needed items for all sites.

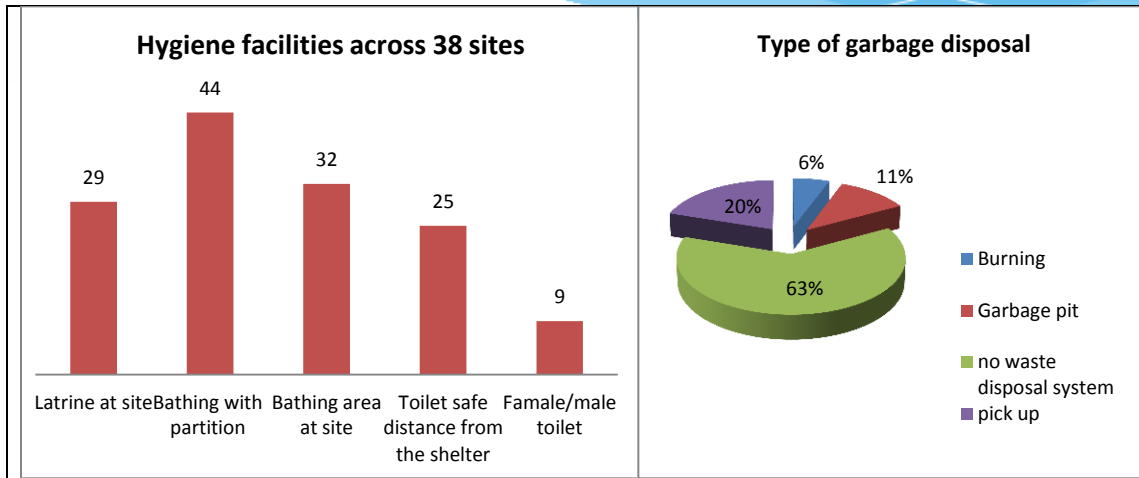
### Water

- Majority sites does not have a main water source. There are 12 Evacuation Centers with on-site water source. Two other locations have hand water-pumps.
- Primary drinking water sources includes: bottled / purified water, mineral water, water truck, swallow wells and LMWD.



### Hygiene and Sanitation

- Majority of the sites has several latrines and minimum one bathing area. There are a total 211 latrines across 29 sites and five sites are reported has latrine. Five sites equipped with 8 to 12 bathing areas with partition.



- A total of 22 sites have no waste/garbage disposal system in place yet. The garbage disposal at sites are functioning through various methods such as pick up (7 centers), garbage pit (4 centers), and incineration (2 centers).

### Health

- Cough, colds, fever, skin disease, injury, wound infection are the most common diseases facing by the IDPs
- It is reported that the Department of Health (DoH) conducted Surveillance in Post Extreme Emergencies and Disasters (**SPEED**) at 8 sites. While the remaining 30 sites have no visit from DoH.
- Seven centers received health services from the following organization/entities: City Hall, WHO, DoH Davao Medical Mission, Team Albay, JICA amongst others. In addition, health referral systems have been established at seven sites.

### Education:

- The children are not going to school and there is no informal education activities being conducted at the site.
