DMT results and analysis for Typhoon Haiyan, No.006

Date: 22 November 2013

Number of centers: 5

Total Households: 269; Total persons: 1,325

From the DTM conducted for 5 sites, the highlights are as follows:

Shelter

- Type of dwelling facilities are classroom
- All **five** sites have no on-site electricity
- No on-site cooking available across 5 sites assessed
- It is reported that all displaced require shelter materials to return to their places of origin.

Food

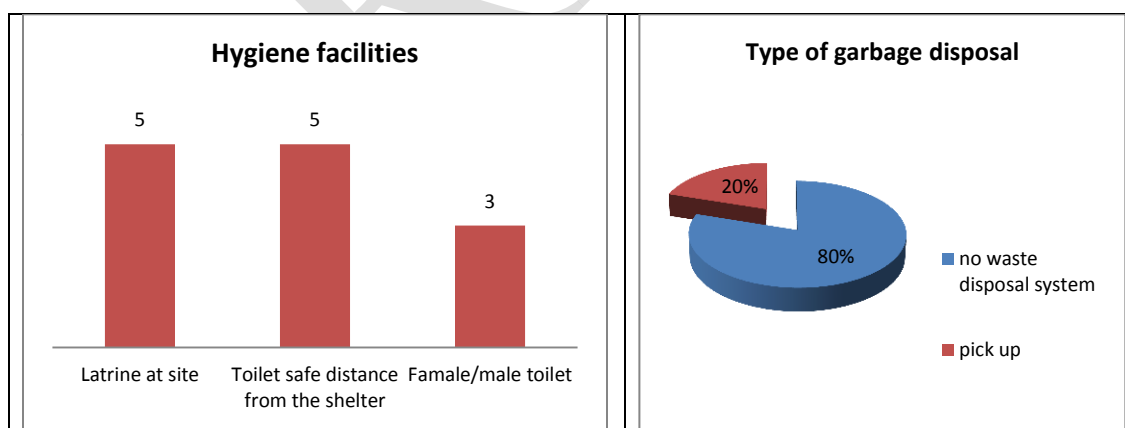
- **Two** sites received twice a week food supplies and remaining three sites have no expected schedule for food distribution
- Food and food supplement are highly needed

Water

- **One** site using hand pump to extract water and 4 sites have access to city water.
- Primary drinking water sources includes: bottled purified, mineral water, bottled water, water truck, swallow wells and LMWD.

Hygiene and Sanitation

- 40 latrines are reported across 5 sites. One site has several latrines (Macabug Elementary School), but **there is no water available**
- Three sites have separate female/male toilets; all five sites are reported to have toilets within safe distance from shelter
- **80% sites** (four sites) have no waste disposal system



Health

- Cough, colds, fever, diarrhea are the most common diseases faced by the IDPs
- There is no visit from the Department of Health (DoH) for conducting Surveillance in Post Extreme Emergencies and Disasters (**SPEED**).
- Two centers received a health service from the following organization/entities Balay Mindanao and Korean Rescue

Education:

- The children are not going to school and there is no informal education activities being conducted at the site.
- The school will resume from December 2nd and the evacuees supposed to be evacuated by that time

Protection:

- Only **one site** has 24-hours security on-site and one site has child friendly space
- **One** incident, fighting among residents is reported occurred in one site

Additional notes from the sites on persons with special vulnerabilities

- There are plenty of vulnerability cases located at one site (City Central School) including: 15 pregnant women, 100 breastfeeding mothers, 20 persons with disabilities; 10 persons with serious medical condition/chronic diseases; 20 unaccompanied minors
